## TASTING NOTES

From the higher and cooler foothills of the Provence Alps, Artea bursts with aromatics well beyond those offered in the more supple wines further to the south.

A pretty and lifted nose of fresh raspberries, wild strawberry and hints of aniseed spice. Lively and bursting with fruit, this is delicious with a fresh finish

## ALPES DE HAUTE PROVENCE IGP

An IGP title that covers wines from the administrative department of the same name in the foothills of the Alps. It exists to give a geographical classification to wines which do not qualify (either stylistically or geographically) for AOC-level Coteaux de Pierrevert.

Given the altitude and vineyard sites, hot sunny days are followed by much cooler nights and a lighter, more aromatic style is the hallmark of the wines. Predominant varieties are consistent with classic Provencal blends of Grenache, Syrah & Cinsault.
